Prom Photography

We have arranged for a photographer to be on site at Conexus Arts Centre for the formal portion of the evening. The photographer will be taking shots of grads as they enter during the Grand March. This saves parents and guests the challenge of trying to capture a photo during their graduate's entrance. It also reduces congestion, as our parents can remain seated during the Grand March knowing a photographer will be capturing shots.

Photos from prom night will be uploaded to a password protected photo gallery that students can view and download from. Please note that by purchasing a ticket to prom, you agree to have your graduate's photo(s) uploaded to a password protected image gallery. The password to this gallery will be shared with graduates closer to Prom.

We will also have a photo booth set up so that grads can snap fun photos with their friends, classmates, and escorts throughout the night.

Graduate Student Slideshow

The Student Prom Committee will be compiling a slideshow to celebrate the graduating class. We kindly ask that you share 2 photos of your grad (then and now). For your "then" photo – please share a baby photo or first day of school type shot. For the "now" photo – we ask that you share a cap & gown photo. If you did not get a cap & gown photo, please submit their Grade 12 school photo or another more recent shot.

By submitting a picture, you are consenting for the picture to be used in the Graduate Student Slideshow that will play on June 27, 2026. The picture will *not* be used for any other purpose and will only be shown during the Prom event.

Prom Agenda

All Prom events are organized by the Parent Committee.

What is the purpose of Prom?

Prom is an opportunity for students to dress up in their formal gowns and suits and celebrate this special occasion with friends and family. They have worked hard to reach this milestone, and Prom is an opportunity to let loose and celebrate with their peers one final time before going their separate ways post-grad.

How many guests can I bring?

Each graduate may invite up to four guests to Prom, *not* including an optional escort. Once attendance numbers are confirmed, a limited number of additional tickets may become available for purchase. If you're interested in purchasing extra tickets, please email sheldonprom2026@gmail.com, indicate your first and last name and the number of additional tickets you would like to purchase. While additional tickets are *not* guaranteed, we will do our best to accommodate requests.

How much do tickets cost?

The Prom Planning Committee is working hard to organize several fundraisers so we can keep ticket costs as low as possible. Prom ticket fees cover the costs for venue rental, decorations, a DJ, a photo booth, casino games, as well as the buffet meal for graduates (and optional escorts).

As you can appreciate, these costs add up quickly. While we don't know our final ticket pricing quite yet, cost for prom tickets typically falls within the \$120 - \$140 range. This price is dependent upon the total number of tickets sold.

Each ticket covers entry and a meal for the graduate, as well as entry for up to 4 guests per grad (ceremony only - no meal included for guests). Grads wishing to bring an escort will be required to purchase an escort meal ticket for an additional \$55.

How do I purchase prom tickets?

We are currently finalizing the ticketing platform details and will share a link to order tickets shortly. Please follow our Instagram account "[swcprom26](#)" as we'll be sharing the link there. We'll also be sharing the link on Edsby in the **Graduating Class of 2026 group**.

Prom Timeline

5:00pm	Doors open at Conexus Arts Centre
5:15pm	Grads line up for Grand March (ALL Grads must be present by this time)
5:45pm	Grand March (Convention Hall – lower level)
6:15pm	Formal program begins (Convention Hall – lower level)
7:00pm	ROOM TURNAROUND - PARENTS & GUESTS DEPART
7:15pm	Buffet Dinner (Jacqui Shumiatcher Room – lower level) Grads & optional escorts only
8:00pm	Dance & Casino (Convention Hall – lower level) Grads & optional escorts only
11:00pm	Prom concludes

*Times are approximate based on number of Graduates participating in ceremonies.

Please note: following the formal program portion of the evening, there will be a brief intermission to allow parents and guests time to depart while graduates (and optional escorts) move to the Jacqui Shumiatcher room for the buffet supper. **Parents and guests are not permitted to stay for the meal and are kindly asked to depart promptly at 7pm so Conexus Arts Centre staff can convert the convention hall space for the dance to follow.**

Fundraising Activities

Prom can be an exciting milestone, but we understand it can also be costly for families. To help reduce ticket prices and make Prom more accessible, the Parent Committee will be hosting several fundraising activities in the spring. Our goal is to keep costs as low as possible and to support families who may need financial assistance so every graduate can take part. Step 1

Visit a SARCAN Depot and look for Drop & Go.

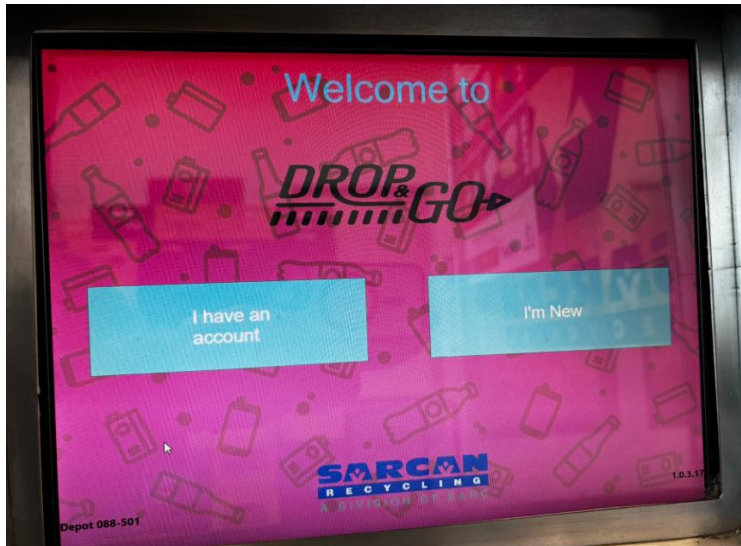

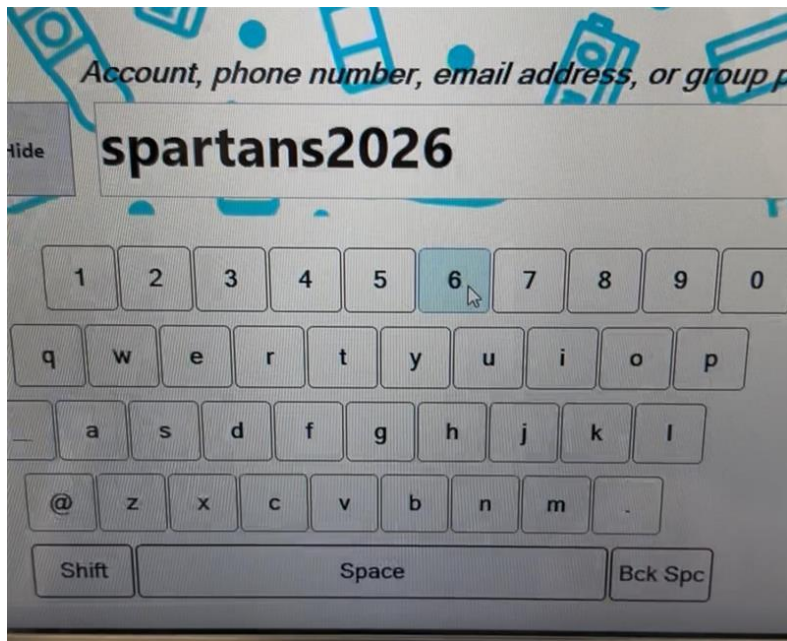
Step 3

Follow these instructions:

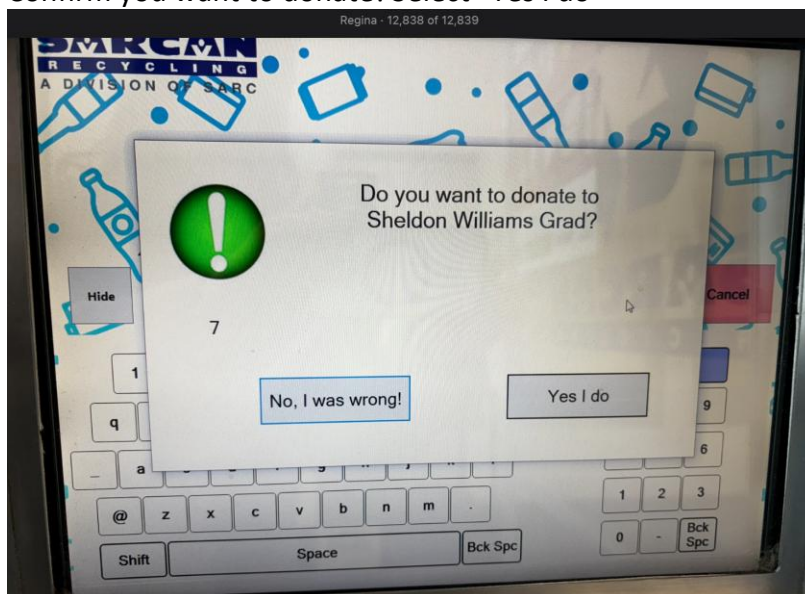
Select "I have an account"



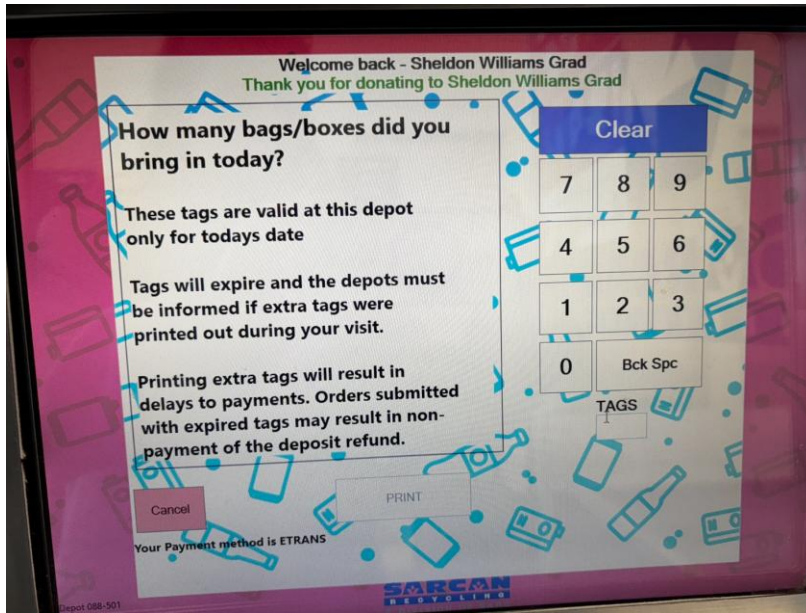
Type "Spartans2026" and select Login (green button)

Signs will be available for purchase during Parent Conferences on March 26 (payment may be made by cash or e-transfer to sheldonprom2026@gmail.com).

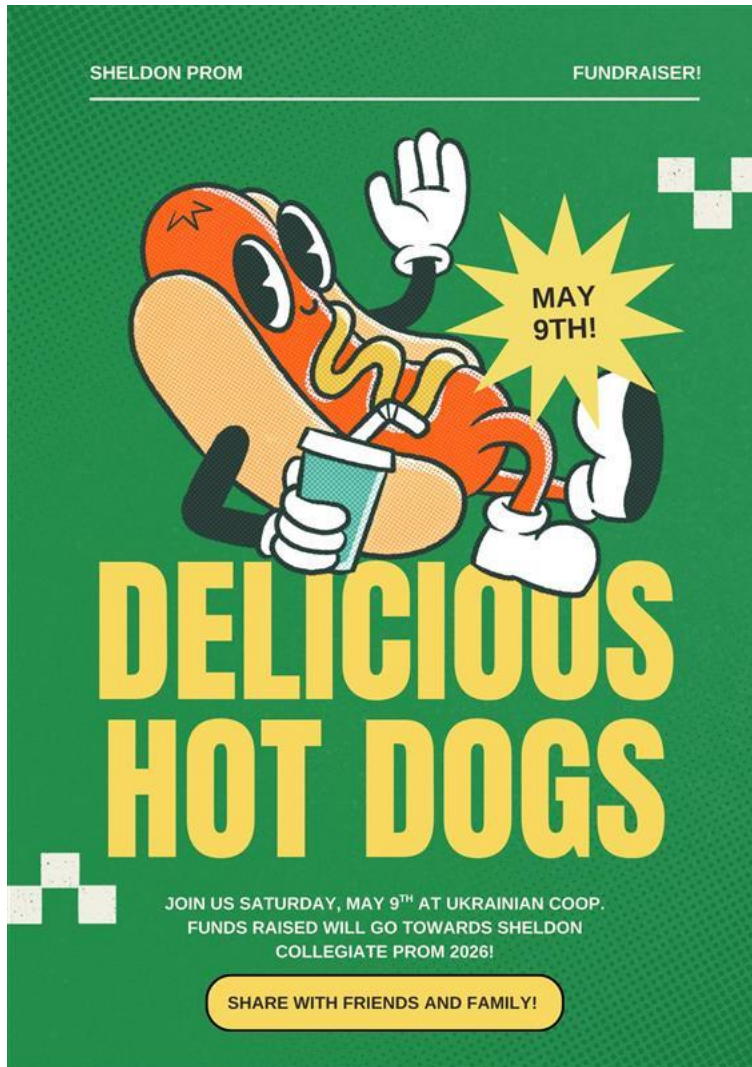

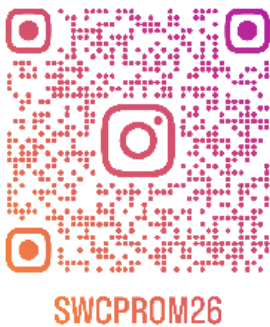
Venue Location
